

RVF Board Meeting
June 19,2004
Jackson, Wyoming

President Ken Calderwood called the meeting to order at 3 PM. He advised that the main purpose of the meeting was to discuss plans for the 2005 Rally.

Board members attending: Al Brieger, Ken Calderwood, Bob Craig, Jerry Haley, Bob Hamblin, Lloyd Hendry, Fred Royce, Jim Smith, Jack Spencer, Carter Wind and Chuck Ward. In addition, George Partlo also was in attendance.

George Partlo read a report detailing problems with Rotary International and the city of Chicago regarding setting up a rally location in Chicago during the International Convention in 2005. Nothing is fixed as of this date although parking is apparently available at McCormick Place. George prefers the parking facilities at Soldiers Field. A possible option is to have the RVF portion of the rally at an RV Park southwest of Chicago and then caravan to Soldier's field on Friday or Saturday June 18 or 19. George Partlo stated he plans to meet with Mayor Richard Daley of Chicago to outline what is needed and to hopefully secure his approval. This was followed by considerable discussion. Since nothing was fixed, no decisions could be made. Basically, the problem is in the hands of George Partlo and Ken Calderwood.

Directors signed a letter expressing their objection to RI not providing liability insurance for Recreational Fellowships (The secretary wishes to express his appreciation for the assistance provided by Bob Craig and Al Brieger).

A memo from Don Billings was distributed to the membership prior to the meeting. Comments were requested, but everyone was exhausted after the lengthy and seemingly inconclusive meeting.

Meeting adjourned at approximately 4:45 PM.
